### **Scholarship Requirements:**

1. The applicant must be a female who is enrolling in the second year or later of a construction related degree program in a university, college, or vocational/trade school in the United States. The program must be designed to be completed in two or more years.
2. The applicant must attend full-time, as defined by the institution attended.
3. Completed applications received before the deadline above will be reviewed by the NAWIC Chapter 346 Scholarship Committee and a winner will be chosen by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
4. A Scholarship Acceptance Form will be emailed to the prospective recipient as soon as the winner is chosen. This form must be completed and returned within 14 days from award notification. Please be sure to include a current email address on the application to avoid delays.
5. Payment will be made directly to the school on the scholarship recipient's behalf only after successful completion of the first year in a construction-related degree program and evidence of enrollment in a second year. Student must achieve a minimum 2.5 grade point average (based on a 4.0 system).
6. It will be the student's responsibility to forward a copy of the first year grades and proof of enrollment in the second year of the program in order to receive the funds. This documentation must be received by our Chapter no later than July 31, 2019 or the scholarship will be forfeited.
7. Funds will be distributed directly to the college on the student's behalf within 30 days of receipt of the above documentation.
